UPDATE TO PICANet DATASET – AUGUST 2014

The beginning of August saw the roll out of the revised **Admission, Transport and Referral datasets** on **PICANet Web**. Changes include additional PIM 3 variables for the admission and transport datasets, two new daily intervention variables for high flow nasal cannula therapy and unplanned extubation for the admissions data-set and amendments to the referral and transport datasets. The additional data items can only be submitted via PICANet Web.

PICANet would like to thank all of the organisations for their help in making the transition to the new datasets as smooth and as swift as possible. 
