4th National Audit Project (NAP4) **Major airway Complications** in UK Anaesthetic, Critical **Care and Emergency Department Care**

The Royal College of Anaesthetists (RCoA) is undertaking a project to prospectively identify and review all major airway problems relating to anaesthesia, emergency and ICU care, over a one year period. This project, NAP4, will run from 1 Sept 2008 - 31 August 2009. During that period all PICUs are invited, indeed strongly encouraged, to report all cases of major complications of airway management that they see. These may be cases that are admitted as a result of events. outside PICU, or events that arise during a patient's stay on PICU.
