PICANet 2013 Annual Meeting attended by over 100 delegates

The **PICANet 2013 Annual Meeting** was held on Wednesday 13th November in Bristol, over 100 delegates attended from across the paediatric intensive care and wider health community.

The audience heard an overview of the latest findings from the PICANet annual report and future developments for the audit including data on referrals and transport to intensive care and new outcome measures such as ventilator free days.



Guest speakers reported on a project to use PICANet data to follow up children who had cardiac surgery in infancy, a system for gaining information on early life congenital anomalies through reporting cards for surgeons, and a study to understand more about the treatment given to children with refractory convulsive status epilepticus, amongst other relevant topics.

PICANet Admission Dataset update

1. Coding of Operations and procedures performed during this admission - where the type of admission is Planned - following surgery or Unplanned - following surgery users will be required to code at least one operation or procedure for the admission event.

Definition: Any operation and/or procedures performed during admission or immediately prior to this admission to PICU.

E.g. a trachea-oesophageal fistula repair performed for oesophageal atresia.

This change to the dataset has been agreed by the Clinical Advisory Group and will be implemented on **January 1**st **2014**. A validation query will be added to PICANet web if a code is not recorded.

- 2. High flow nasal oxygen The Chapter XB Paediatric Critical Care Expert Working Group have agreed that high flow nasal cannula oxygen should be recorded as **Supplemental oxygen therapy (irrespective of ventilatory state)** on the daily interventions record and NOT as Non-invasive ventilatory support.
- 3. PICANet are currently seeking confirmation of the PIM3 definitions prior to addition to the dataset.

PICANet are aware that changes to the dataset impact on staff collecting the data and may also require amendments to unit clinical information systems. All changes to the PICANet dataset are agreed by the Clinical Advisory Group and the Steering Group prior to implementation and PICANet will always allow a lead time for units to introduce the agreed changes.
