REGIONAL REPORTS PUBLISHED

We are pleased to say that the **PICANet Reports for Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland,** on activity and outcomes in paediatric intensive care have now been published on the PICANet website.

From this year onwards our regional reports will be anonymised to suppress cell counts less than 5 to prevent the possibility of individuals being identified. In some cases this has led to whole tables or figures being suppressed and a number of other tables having data missing. In future years, data may be aggregated to prevent the presence of small numbers. If you require access to the complete versions of the tables a request can be made to PICANet using the standard data request form available on the PICANet website.

PICANet DATASET UPDATE

PICANet will be amending the **admission and transport dataset to permit collection of PIM 3 data items**. Seizure disorder, necrotising enterocolitis and bone marrow transplant will be collected and the field recovery from surgery will define the type of procedure (cardiac bypass or non-bypass, elective liver transplant or other procedure).

PICANet are aware that changes to the dataset impact on staff collecting the data and may also require amendments to unit clinical information systems. All changes to the PICANet dataset are agreed by the Clinical Advisory Group and the Steering Group prior to implementation and PICANet will always allow a lead time for units to introduce the agreed changes.
