

## PICANet EVALUATION OF POST CARDIAC ARREST CARE IN KIDS (NET-PACK 2)

Thank you to all units that participated in the **NET-PACK 2 Study**. Data collection ran from the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2014 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2015 with 23 units taking part. The study now has sufficient data to meet its aims. Once again **thank you for your participation** in this study.

## 'Your Experience Counts' -PIC Families Questionnaire

Questionnaires have been circulated to participating units for the next round of the 'Survey of Parental Experience during admission of your child to the paediatric intensive care unit (PICU)'; taking place from February 1st to February 29th 2016.

Unit staff are asked to ensure that a copy of the survey is given to the parents or carers of each child when their child's discharge from PICU is anticipated, encouraging completion at the end of their stay on PICU. The timing is important because one question requires a response to the statement "we were well prepared for our child's discharge from paediatric intensive care - by the doctors/nurses".

Data entry of all questionnaires returned in 2015 was completed in December and is now being analysed for the unit reports which we expect to return to you by the end of March 2016.
