#### PICANet Team News

Since its inception in 2002, PICANet has been run jointly by the three Universities of Leicester, Leeds and Sheffield.

In February, Gareth Parry, the Principal Investigator based in Sheffield left to take up the post of Director of Quality Measurement & Analysis at Boston Children's Hospital, Harvard Medical School. Partly as a result of this, from October 2006, PICANet will be run by staff solely based in Leicester and Leeds. This means the staff based at Sheffield will no longer be involved with PICANet. Gill Ryder and Tim Chater will be leaving PICANet at the end of June and Sam Jones will stay in post until the end of October.

Angie Willshaw has been employed in Leeds to take over the administration of the project and a new research nurse will be taken on in Leicester sometime in the Autumn.

Unfortunately, all the staff changes mean that the team are unable to carry out any validation visits at present.

#### National Report

This year's PICANet National Report covers the two year period January 2004 - December 2005 and presents data on over 28.000 PICU admissions.

For the first time the individual NHS trusts are identified in this report.

A new chapter presents data on individual children who have been admitted to a PICU on more than one occasion. There is also a clinical chapter, written in collaboration with Mark Darowski and Roddy O'Donnell, on children under one year admitted to a PICU with acute respiratory failure.

The report will be distributed mid June and all recipients of this newsletter will automatically be sent a copy.
