PICANet Web

The new web based system was launched on the 1st October, 2011. 28 units and 2 centralised transport services are now successfully entering/exporting data to PICANet Web and 5 units are awaiting transfer. Of these 2 are being contacted to establish timelines for migration and the remaining 3 units are currently introducing new clinical information systems and developing the facility to export to PICANet Web.

Referral & Transport Data

Referral and transport data should be submitted by the PICU or Centralised Transport Service taking the referral call and or providing the transport. 11 units have now entered referral and transport data into the database and a further three have entered referral data only. Those units not yet submitting data will be contacted by PICANet to ascertain how they plan to proceed. Contact picanet@leeds.ac.uk if you have any queries.

New features to the PICANet web system

During our scheduled downtime on October 2nd we deployed several new features and updates to PICANet Web:

- * **Export** You can download your organisation's data for local use and analysis. PICUs partaking in Payment by results (PbR) can also download PCCMDS data.
- * Open by Event ID You can quickly open an event from the Dashboard by typing its Event ID.
- * Clinical coding We have improved the search results returned by the clinical coder when entering diagnoses and procedures.

- * **Reports** We have added summary validation reports for Referral, Transport and Admission events.
- * Import We have enhanced the Import procedure to help you diagnose any compatibility issues with data shared from local clinical systems. Now, before starting a time-consuming import, PICANet Web will quickly compare the data file you upload against the published schema, and will report and reject any unexpected content.
- * **Encryption** All personally identifiable information is now protected on the database server with high grade AES 256-bit encryption
